1. Apologies.

3. Minutes of the previous Meeting.

ON THE PROPOSITION of the Cllr Riordan, **SECONDED** by Cllr Terry, **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the Meeting held on Thursday 3rd December, 2009 having been circulated, be signed as a true and correct record of the Meeting.

4. Job Descriptions.

Members understood that the Clerk had not been able to action the re-formatting of the job descriptions due to the importance of other issues, with no anticipated target date set.

5. Correspondence.

Following consideration, **AS PREVIOUSLY RESOLVED** that, for this and future meetings, the correspondence and staff matters, under Section 100A of the Local Government Act 1972, in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted, it is advisable in the public interest, as if members of the public were present during the consideration of such business, there would be disclosure to them of exempt information under paras 1 and 11 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the said Act, that the public be temporarily excluded and they are instructed to withdraw.
